### Troika card

Troika is a smart transport card that unites every type of tickets and makes using the ground transportation easier.



Troika benefits:

- Your independence from queues, cashiers and time of day shall be used through the internet as easy as topping-up your mobile phone but without charge and with the rate up to 3000 ₺.
- Freedom to use any public transport — one card is used to pay for public transportation and commuter trains.
- Free usage — the 50 ₺ security deposit can be returned at any time (if the card is brought back undamaged).
- Stability — the card has no expiration date and its balance does not expire for 5 years after the last top-up.

E-wallet rates:

- One trip by metro, monorail or MCC — 36 ₺.
- One trip by any ground transportation — 36 ₺.
- 90 Minutes pass for one metro, monorail or MCC ride and unlimited number of transfers to ground transport within 90 minutes — 56 ₺.

### Hours of operation

The Moscow Metro is open for passengers from 5:30 a.m. till 1 a.m. The timetable for trains departing after 1 a.m. can be found on [www.mosmetro.ru](http://www.mosmetro.ru).

### Moscow Central Circle

The Moscow Central Circle (MCC) is a part of the city's modern transportation system designed to distribute passenger flows.

The MCC is open between 5:30 a.m. and 1 a.m. Trains run every 5–10 minutes.

The transfer from the Metro to the MCC is free within 90 minutes from entering the metro.

### Rules for using the metro


- Pay your fare and don't jump over turnstiles.
- Baggage is paid for separately.
- Children under the age of 7 travel for free, and strollers and kids bikes are transported free of charge.
- Smoking and drinking alcohol is prohibited.
- Amateur photography without tripod or flash is allowed. For professional photography and video recording, permission is required.


### Advice and information

At the Live Service counters, passengers can get information about public transport routes and find how to get to particular sights and points of interest.

The app is available on App Store and Google Play.


